Dear Mr. Grittner:

A clause was inadvertently omitted from the last sentence of the Response of the Minnesota State Canvassing Board to Petition for an Order to Show Cause Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 204B.44. The sentence should read as follows (the omitted language is shown in bold):

**If, based upon the arguments of the candidates, this Court deems it appropriate, it could address a process for correction of any errors which exist regarding the counting of original/duplicate ballots discovered by local election officials acting as recount officials and, the local officials can submit amended recount summaries to the Board, which can consider those corrections in its certification of the final election results for the United States Senate.**
