**How do volunteers become trained/qualified to register voters**

Volunteers must each take a class to become qualified. These are run by local registrar. They typically do them at 10 and 3, Tuesday and Thursday, but they can schedule special classes for large groups. They typically last 30 minutes.

Once you've been to a class you'll be issued a voter registration number and 50 forms with that number on them (each volunteer has their own number, so no trading). They're three part forms. Once you turn in the first 50, you can get another 50. The forms must also be turned in within 48 hours of being filled out.

When registering someone to vote, you must sign the form and give them one copy. Then you keep one copy and turn one in to the elections office.

**How do you turn in forms?**

They can go to either the county office or the state, but they **MUST** be in within 48 hours of being filled out.

**Special rules on how forms are filled out?**

See above.

**Can we keep records of voter registrations?**

**Who can register where and ID issues**

Students can all register. They need to show an id (DL, utility bill, voter id that is mailed to them, social security number and signature are all fine). If the address on their DL doesn't match, they should bring a utility bill.
