

Within 14 days, the defendants will submit to the magistrate judge (but not file) and serve on counsel for the plaintiffs a summary of their objections to the plaintiffs' fee and cost request. The plaintiffs will respond in the same manner within 10 days thereafter. The submissions to the magistrate judge should not exceed three pages each. The magistrate judge will make a settlement proposal thereafter.
