DECLARATION OF TARONN L. ALLEN

I, Taronn L. Allen, being of sound mind and with personal knowledge of the facts, do make this declaration pursuant to 28 U.S.C. ¶ 1746(2), under penalty of perjury:

1. I am a citizen of the United States and am eighteen years old. I have lived in the State of Ohio and the Mohican Juvenile Correction Facility in Ashland County in excess of thirty days immediately before the election on November 4, 2008. I am not scheduled to be released before November 4, 2008.

2. On or about October 6, 2008, I filled out a voter registration form. I gave the form to Laurie Wen who told me she would hand deliver it to the Ashland County Board of Elections on October 6, 2008.


3. On October 23, 2008, I received a notice from the Ashland County Board of Elections stating that my registration was being challenged at a hearing on October 24, 2008.

4. By the time I received the notice, I was unable to get a court order to attend the hearing or to find a lawyer to represent me. Because of the short notice, I wasn't able to attend the hearing.

5. I've since learned that the Board of Elections canceled my registration at the hearing.

6. I really want to vote. Now that I am old enough, I realize how important voting is. I've been paying attention to the election and want to vote.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the above statements are true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
