All that Appellants ask at this point is for the Court to order provisional ballots to be provided to Appellants so that their right to vote will be preserved pending this appeal. It would be unfortunate for Appellants to lose their voting rights should this Court agree that Appellants' interpretation of the statutes is correct.
