

Entry and Order from Discovery Conference

The magistrate judge held a discovery conference on March 4, 2010, with counsel regarding the scope of discovery in advance of the scheduled April 30, 2010 settlement conference. The court orders that the plaintiffs may take (1) a 30(b)(6) deposition on policy and procedures, (2) deposition(s) regarding the defendants' computer systems, (3) and 1 managerial and 1 receptionist deposition for one of each of the three types of counties. Counsel shall confer with one another in good faith to schedule these depositions. Nothing in this order, however, requires the defendants to produce all of these witnesses for deposition before the April 30 conference if they cannot reasonably do so after conferring in good faith regarding scheduling. If all the depositions cannot be completed before the settlement conference and the plaintiffs continue to insist upon them, the court will entertain a motion to continue the settlement conference.
